## **Getting to Inverness:**

Whatever travel option you decide upon please try to get to Inverness sometime during Friday morning or very early afternoon to give us enough time to transfer you to the hotel in Lossiemouth, and for you to go on the dolphin & wildlife watching boat trip.

If you would like to go to Chanonry Point for the shore based dolphin watching with Charlie Phillips on the Monday morning then you will need to arrange return flights etc for late afternoon onwards.

## **By Air:**

The main companies flying to Inverness are Easyjet and Flybe.

### **Easyjet - [www.easyjet.com](http://www.easyjet.com)**

Flights go from London Gatwick, London Luton and Bristol airports. Based on the summer 2009 schedules, flights tend to leave UK airports around lunchtime on a Friday, getting into Inverness late afternoon. Flights from Inverness tend to leave mid afternoon on a Monday, getting into the UK late afternoon.

### **Flybe – [www.flybe.com](http://www.flybe.com)**

Flights go from Belfast City, Birmingham, London Gatwick and Manchester. Based on the 2009 schedules, flights tend to leave UK airports early to mid morning on a Friday, getting into Inverness late morning. Flights from Inverness tend to leave late afternoon on a Monday, getting into the UK early evening.

## **By Rail:**

There is also an overnight sleeper service from London. Based on 2009 schedules trains go from London Euston:

Euston - 21.15 (arrive Inverness at 08.30)

Inverness – 20.38 (arrive Euston 07.47)
